**English qualification:** If you aren't a native English speaker, or if you haven't spent the last 3 years in an English medium school, students will require TOEFL score of minimum 525 points for the paper based test and 70 on the Internet Based Test (IBT). Cambridge First Certificate Exam (FCE) with Grade C. IELTS, with an overall band score of 5.5 and at least 5.0 in each discipline. The school may require a phone or personal interview before admission into the programme.

#### ORTHOPTIC

The University of Sheffield, UK, invites applications for BMedSci (Hons) Orthoptic course starting in September 2017. This three-year full time vocational degree includes theoretical teaching and practical clinical experience necessary for professional practise as an orthoptist. The students go on clinical placements in eye departments at hospitals across the UK, Ireland and Gibraltar. The degree is approved by the Health and Care Professions Council.

**Eligibility: Minimum 75**



per cent marks in Class XII with 75 per cent in any one out of Biology or Human Biology, Maths, Chemistry or Physics. International Baccalaureate students should have 32 points, 6 in either higher level Biology, Maths, Chemistry or Physics. Biology is preferred. Students from EU and international students will require IELTS 7.0 with a minimum of 6.5 in each component.

**Fee:** International students will be required to pay a tuition fee of £20,470 per year.

#### HEALTH MANAGEMENT

International Institute of Health Management Research Delhi invites application for admission to its PG Diploma in Health Management (PGDHM).

**Eligibility Requirements:** Bachelor's degree in any discipline with a minimum of 50 per cent marks in the aggregate. They should have taken any one of the Management Aptitude Test like CAT/MAT/XAT/ATMA/ GMAT/CMAT. Candidates appearing at the final year examination of the Bachelor's degree or waiting for the results of their final year degree examinations in 2017 may also apply.

Selected candidates will be given provisional admission. They will be required to produce evidence of their graduation within two months of admission. For working executives, they are exempted from written Management Aptitude Test but aspirants should have a minimum of two years relevant work experience in the healthcare sector.
